François Fillion showcased his probity to be elected at the right- wing's primary but we found out that he did not apply those principales to himself. This case showed mental mechanisms which conduct a man to feel exempt from a exercise power. Those who thought they would change the presidential function were actually changed by it. Does the power would have more impact on brain than brain on power?
